

**WEST HOLLYWOOD SENIOR ADVISORY BOARD
MINUTES**

I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 2:03 p.m. by Chairperson Walkup.

A. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

C. POSTING OF THE AGENDA

D. PROCEDURE FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

E. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the September 26, 2012 meeting were approved.

III. ITEMS FROM THE PUBLIC

Dr. John Foster spoke about a new urgent care clinic in West Hollywood and announced its services.

IV. ITEMS FROM THE SENIOR CENTER AND THE ACTIVITY PROGRAM

Nancy Desser announced that there is a waitlist for the following trips: Camarillo Outlet stores on 12/6, the Showtime Cabaret on 12/12 and the Norton Simon museum on 12/20. A lecture on eye health for Seniors will be held on 12/13 from 1:30-2:30 and feature eye glass adjustments.

V. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

A. Jeff Book spoke about the term limits initiative which will be on the City ballot in March. If passed, it would limit the terms of Councilmembers to three 4-year terms. Current terms would not count in the calculation for limits. The initiative qualified for the ballot with 3,211 verified signatures—it was required to have at least 10% of the registered voters' signatures, of which there are 23,438.

VI. NEW BUSINESS

A. The Board discussed topics and presentations for Board meetings in the coming year. Suggestions included a discussion on public safety with the Sheriff's Captain, and updates on the following: Plummer Park improvements, plans for Movietown Plaza, the hoarding program, use of the Sheriffs' property at Santa Monica and San Vicente, assistance devices at the Library for people living with disabilities.

VII. ITEMS FROM BOARD MEMBERS

Lee Walkup announced that the City x 1 event to be held for LGBT youth for the holidays will be on December 16 at 6 and volunteers are encouraged! He spoke about the tribute event for Rita Norton. He also announced that he would be gone for the next SAB meeting because he is attending events in Washington DC for President Obama' Inaugural.

Muriel Schoichet spoke about the terrible traffic on Orlando.

VIII. ITEMS FROM STAFF


