Action: To approve the Entertainment with Dance
business license for Howard Gottlieb dba
The Palms with the following conditions:

- 1) Applicant continues to comply with the City's
Noise Ordinance - Section 4300 of the West
Hollywood Municipal Code (Attachment B).
- 2) The door to the patio remains shut except for
access (ingress and egress) and remain shut
except for emergency after 10:00 p.m.
- 3) The patio area is closed at 10:00 p.m.
- 4) Live entertainment will be limited to four (4)
persons.
- 5) The manager shall be an on-site licensed
manager.
- 6) Live entertainment will take place on the
existing dance floor.
