## Directions to West Hollywood Council Chambers & Parking Information

The Library is a tall white building located at 625 N. San Vicente Boulevard between Santa Monica and Melrose Avenue. There are two street entrances to the library parking structures, from the East on San Vicente Boulevard and from the West on Robertson Boulevard. Both entrances lead to two parking structures. The one-story library parking structure is open for library patrons only. Visitors attending special events at the Library should use the five-story public parking structure. Visitors using the San Vicente street entrance should continue to the end of the building on the left where the parking lot entrance is located.

### Directions to City of West Hollywood Council Chambers

The Council Chambers are located on the South side of the Library AutoCourt adjacent to San Vicente Blvd. The lobby contains a large Shepard Fairey mural and Coffee shop. Visitors may access the AutoCourt and the Chambers from the first floor of the 5-story parking structure.

If you are involved in an event, you may stop temporarily (5 minutes) with blinkers on in the loading zone in front of the Council Chambers to unload and then move your car into the 5-Story Parking Structure.

For all special events which have had parking for attendees waived by Council Item, there will be a validation machine at the event for people to validate their bar-coded ticket which attendees should bring with them.
