B. Coast Playhouse Programming Application – Chris Isaacson Presents/Ford Foundation

The Subcommittee will consider a proposal for use of the Coast Playhouse on June 4 or 5, 2018 by the Chris Isaacson Presents/Ford Foundation for “The Laramie Project,” a one-night celebrity reading in conjunction with the 20th anniversary of the death of Matthew Shepard.

C. WeHo Arts Community Grant Application – Critical Mass Dance Company

The Subcommittee will review a WeHo Arts Community Grant application submitted by Critical Mass Dance Company. The Subcommittee will also consider recommending that the Arts and Cultural Affairs Commission approve a grant of \$1,000 to support the Critical Mass Dance Company’s “Women’s Empowerment Program,” which will offer a 6-week healing movement class to survivors of sexual violence, domestic violence, or childhood molestation at Peace over Violence from April 10 - May 15.

RECOMMENDATION: Consider recommending that the Arts and Cultural Affairs Commission approve WeHo Arts Community Grant of \$1,000 to Art Treasures to support the Critical Mass Dance Company’s “Women’s Empowerment Program” at Peace over Violence.

D. WeHo Arts Community Grant Application – Global Musical Bridges

The Subcommittee will review a WeHo Arts Community Grant application submitted by Global Musical Bridges. The Subcommittee will also consider recommending that the Arts and Cultural Affairs Commission approve a grant of \$1,000 to support Global Musical Bridges’ “145th Sergey Rachmaninoff’s Anniversary music festival” which take place at Fiesta Hall from April 27 - April 29.

RECOMMENDATION: Consider recommending that the Arts and Cultural Affairs Commission approve WeHo Arts Community Grant of \$1,000 to Art Treasures to support Global Musical Bridges’ “145th Sergey Rachmaninoff’s Anniversary music festival.”
