This is to notify all Mayors and Councilmembers of Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG) District #41, which represents the Cities of Beverly Hills, Culver City, Santa Monica, and West Hollywood, that the term of appointment for Vice Mayor Meghan Sahli-Wells is set to expire on May 3, 2019. The Westside Cities Council of Governments (WSCOG), in cooperation with SCAG, solicited a call for candidates for SCAG District #41 representative seat on January 7, 2019 and closed the nominations on January 31, 2019. An election will be held to elect the District Representative to serve a two-year term beginning May 4, 2019.

In accordance with the SCAG Regional Council Policy Manual (May 2018), the Regional Council District Representative shall be elected by a majority of a quorum of the COG, which is defined as at least one (1) elected official from 2/3 of the cities in the COG. Nominations from the floor, proxy voting, and teleconferencing are not allowed. In the event of a tie vote, additional balloting shall occur until a District Representative is elected.
