Program Eligibility

To participate in this program, you must be enrolled in the City's On-Call Transportation Program, which requires the following:

- Must live in the City of West Hollywood
- Age 62 or over, or
- Have documented evidence of a disability.

Schedule a delivery

1. Order and pay for groceries from Gelson's, Pavilions, or Sprouts in West Hollywood, which offer online ordering for pickup.
2. Call (310) 981-9303 to request delivery service.
3. Delivery driver will contact you by phone before picking-up your items to confirm your availability to accept the delivery.
4. Once confirmation is received, delivery driver will pickup and deliver your order.



By using this delivery service, customers agree to not hold the City and its transportation partners responsible for any lost or damaged grocery items. Customers should contact the grocery store directly for any issues related to delivered items.
