Receive and file submissions from the design team in accordance with the Urban Art Policy and Guidelines including 1) schematic designs/drawings; site plans and elevations; a narrative description of the proposed art project including how it fits into the environment of the City; and proposed materials and color scheme; 2) implementation timeline; 3) outline of the art budget; 4) maintenance issues and 5) a signed copy of the developer/artist agreement.
