SUBJECT: The Rent Stabilization Commission will consider recommending amendments to the Rent Stabilization Ordinance and Rent Stabilization Regulations to the City Council.

RECOMMENDATIONS: Recommend to the City Council that it approve:

- 1) "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WEST HOLLYWOOD AMENDING CHAPTER 17.08, CHAPTER 17.24, CHAPTER 17.28, CHAPTER 17.32, CHAPTER 17.52 AND CHAPTER 17.56 OF TITLE 17 OF THE WEST HOLLYWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO A PROHIBITION FROM CHARGING ADDITIONAL PET SECURITY DEPOSITS, REGISTRATION AND REREGISTRATION OF NEW CONSTRUCTION AND OTHER SEPARATELY ALIENABLE RESIDENTIAL RENTAL UNITS, PROHIBITION OF SIDE AGREEMENTS, PROHIBITION OF SEPARATE BILLING OF MASTER METERED UTILITY SERVICES, REMOVAL OF PARKING, MINIMUM MAINTENANCE STANDARDS FOR FLOORS AND REGISTRATION OF RESIDENT MANAGER INFORMATION"; and

- 2) "A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST HOLLYWOOD AMENDING RENT STABILIZATION REGULATIONS 20001, 22000, 41001, 60009, 60010, 60032, 60038, 60041, 60046, 60064, 60076, 80009 AND 80010".
