

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Willoughby Ave, Kings Rd, and Vista/Gardner Street Design Project

WHAT IS A PILOT DEMONSTRATION PROJECT?

A pilot demonstration project is temporary in nature (e.g. lasting a few months) and allows the public to experience possible street improvements and provide feedback before a project is permanently installed. If the public feels the pilot demonstration is unsuccessful, it may not be installed permanently. Pilot projects are useful because they give the public time to evaluate and discuss the potential project and because designs can be changed and improved before being permanently installed. Pilot projects are truly a collaborative effort between community members and the city.

WHY WILLOUGHBY, KINGS, AND VISTA/GARDNER?

The City of West Hollywood's Pedestrian and Bicycle Mobility Plan (2017) identified Willoughby Avenue, Kings Road, and Vista/Gardner as streets that provide a missing link in the City's existing bike network. In addition, these residential streets are popular walking routes for residents and visitors. This project protects the safety of both pedestrians and cyclists through strategic street improvements.

Willoughby Avenue is a residential street that runs east/west parallel to Santa Monica Boulevard. Signalized intersections enable morning and evening commuter cut-through traffic for vehicles using this street as an alternative route to Santa Monica Boulevard. This presents potential points of conflicts between vehicles and pedestrians or cyclists who use Willoughby Avenue.

HOW LONG WILL THE TEMPORARY INSTALLATIONS BE UP?

The temporary installations will be up through August 2022, approximately 4 months.

HOW DO I SUBMIT INPUT OR FEEDBACK?
