CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order by Mayor Viterbi at 7:07 P.M.

2a. PROPOSED BENEFIT ASSESSMENT FOR THE CONSOLIDATED FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT OF LOS ANGELES COUNTY: Submitted by the Fire Chief for consideration by the West Hollywood City Council. Jack Bollen, Public Safety Director, reported that the assessment should be \$15.73 per parcel, but this could double within the 10 year time frame.

ACTION: To adopt Resolution No. 340, "A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST HOLLYWOOD, TO SUPPORT THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A BENEFIT ASSESSMENT FOR FIRE SUPPRESSION SERVICES OF THE CONSOLIDATED FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT OF LOS ANGELES COUNTY" and further, that staff send a letter over the signature of the Mayor urging long range planning. Motion Schulte second Albert. Noting the objection of Councilmember Heilman, it was so ordered.
