The Senior Advisory Board received an update from Hernan Molina, Governmental Affairs Liaison for the City of West Hollywood, regarding proposed legislation that, if approved, would amend current state law so that rent-stabilized cities like West Hollywood can require landlords to accommodate the requests for relocation to a ground-level unit from a tenant who is permanently disabled, provided that a comparable size or smaller unit is available.

D. UPDATE ON DOCKLESS MOBILITY PROGRAM

The Senior Advisory Board received an update on the Dockless Mobility Pilot Program (e-bikes and scooters) regarding sidewalk safety from Coby Wagman, Parking Operations Supervisor.

Francisco Gomez, Transportation Services Administrator, spoke about the Senior Advisory Board reappointment process and informed the Board that the City Clerk's office will provide an update.
