**B. Moving Image Media Art Program – Proposal for Exhibitions at 8743 Sunset Boulevard (Invisible Frame), 8901 Sunset (Whisky A Go Go), and 9157 Sunset Boulevard (Streamlined Arbor)**

The Subcommittee will review, and consider recommending Ray Anthony Barrett, Shaghayegh Cyrous, Nathan Hirschaut, Richard Mapes, Julie Orser, Allison Schulnik, and Uta Barth to the Arts and Cultural Affairs Commission artwork for exhibition in the Moving Image Media Art Program (MIMA).

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1) Recommend that the Arts and Cultural Affairs Commission approve the artwork *Go Tell It on the Mountain* by Ray Anthony Barrett for exhibition on the billboard at 9157 Sunset Boulevard (Streamlined Arbor) from October 1, 2023 – January 31, 2024.
- 2) Recommend that the Arts and Cultural Affairs Commission approve the artwork *Xvarnah* (based upon *Golden Hour*) by Shaghayegh Cyrous for exhibition on the billboard at 9157 Sunset Boulevard (Streamlined Arbor) from February 1 – May 31, 2024. Final artwork will be submitted for approval prior to exhibition.
- 3) Recommend that the Arts and Cultural Affairs Commission approve the artwork *Child of the Screen* by Nathan Hirschaut for exhibition on the billboard at 8743 Sunset Boulevard (Invisible Frame) from February 1 – May 31, 2024.

- 4) Recommend that the Arts and Cultural Affairs Commission approve *Lucid Dream* by Richard Mapes for exhibition as the artwork on the billboard at 8901 Sunset Boulevard (Whisky A Go Go) February 1 – May 31, 2024 (anticipated debut of the new billboard).
- 5) Recommend that the Arts and Cultural Affairs Commission approve *Blood Work* by Julie Orser, *Moth* by Allison Schulnik, and *From Dawn to Dusk* by Uta Barth as alternate artworks and artists.
