Commissioner Egbuniwe

Thanked City Clerk, Melissa Crowder, City staff, fellow Commissioners and Councilmember Meister for conducting the Oath of Office. Commissioner Egbuniwe also shared his experience working in the non-profit sector and interest in contributing his experience to assist the Commission in their work.

Commissioner Kacy

Thanked the City Clerk, Melissa Crowder, City staff, fellow Commissioners and Mayor Shyne for conducting the Oath of Office and expressed excitement about working on the Commission.

Commissioner Sotile

11. ITEMS FROM STAFF

Community and Legislative Affairs Supervisor, Jennifer Del Toro notified the Commission that City Council will consider adopting a resolution denouncing the U.S. Supreme Court's recent ruling regarding LGBTQ+ rights at the July 17, 2023, City Council meeting. Jennifer also informed the Commission that the City's Governmental Affairs Liaison, Hernan Molina, will be available to participate in future meetings to share the City's legislative priorities with the Commission and at the next Commission meeting, the Commissioners will be discussing the Rainbow Key Awards.

After discussion, the Commission decided to appoint a representative to speak on behalf of the LGBTQ+ Commission in reference to the resolution denouncing the U.S. Supreme Court's recent ruling regarding LGBTQ+ rights.

ACTION: The Commission voted by consensus to appoint Commissioner Kacy to speak on behalf of the Board regarding this resolution.

The LGBTQ+ Commission adjourned at 8:53 PM to its next regular meeting on Thursday, August 10, 2023, at 7:00 PM, at West Hollywood City Hall – 1st Floor – Community Meeting Room, located at 8300 Santa Monica Boulevard.
