- 1. CALL TO ORDER** – Chair Samala called the meeting to order at 6:38pm
  - A. Land Acknowledgement** – Read by Chair Samala  
*“The West Hollywood Transgender Advisory Board acknowledges that the land on which we gather and that is currently known as the City of West Hollywood is the occupied, unceded, seized territory of the Gabrieleño Tongva and Gabrieleño Kizh peoples.”*

The Oath of Office was administered to newly appointed member June Paniochkine.
  - D. Pledge of Allegiance** – Chair Samala

  - E. Roll Call**

Board Member Nash thanked staff liaison, Moya Marquez for all their contributions, and also expressed gratitude to the subcommittee and Jeff Consoletti for producing a successful Pride event.

*\*Board Member Padilla arrived at 6:49pm.*

Vice Chair Brown expressed gratitude to the Board, staff, and all members that participated in staffing the TAB booth and Pride. Vice Chair Brown also suggested having larger quantities of the Lesbian flag, Bi-sexual flag, and other flags inclusive of the entire LGBTQ+ community. Vice Chair Brown thanked Jeff Consoletti for his work in producing WeHo Pride 2024. Lastly, Vice Chair Brown shared an inappropriate incident that occurred at Pride and encouraged staff and the community to honor the safe and sacred space created by TAB at WeHo Pride events and any event taking place in the City of West Hollywood.

Board Member Dae thanked the subcommittee members, staff and everyone that participated and suggested having hand sanitizer available moving forward. Board Member Dae also recommended that the Board supply the Progressive flag that includes intersex representation and thanked Board Member Singleton for contributing their time at WeHo Pride. Board Member Dae asked if there was a way to rethink banner placement for the TAB Booth in the future.

Staff liaison, Moya Marquez thanked the Board for all their work and efforts and expressed gratitude for their service and contributions to the City of West Hollywood and beyond.

Board Member Paniouchkine suggested having all Transgender focused flags and items at the TAB booth moving forward.

Board Member Padilla recommended compromising between both directions; for example, having a flag that includes all the LGBTQ+ flags to be as inclusive as possible.


### **3. NEW BUSINESS**
