**RECOMMENDATION:**

**B. Moving Image Media Art Program – Proposal for Exhibitions at 8743 Sunset Boulevard (Invisible Frame), 8775 Sunset Boulevard (Spectacular), 9157 Sunset Boulevard (Streamlined Arbor), and 8497 Sunset Boulevard (The Now)**

- 3) Recommend that the Arts and Cultural Affairs Commission approve an adaptation of the artwork, *Metamimics, 2023*, by artist Sara Ludy for exhibition on the billboard at 9157 Sunset Blvd (Streamlined Arbor) from June 1, 2025 - September 30, 2025, and request for the adapted artwork to return to the Subcommittee for approval, prior to exhibition.
- 4) Recommend that the Arts and Cultural Affairs Commission approve the proposal for the site-specific artwork, *New Drop* by Brian Bress as the debut MIMA exhibition on the billboard at 8497 Sunset Blvd (The Now), and request for the adapted artwork to return to the Subcommittee for approval, prior to exhibition.
