Each person addressing the Advisory Board shall do so in an orderly manner and shall not make repetitious, slanderous, or irrelevant remarks, or engage in any other disorderly conduct which disrupts, disturbs, or otherwise impedes the orderly conduct of the Advisory Board meetings. Any person who so disrupts the meeting may, at the discretion of the Presiding Officer or a majority of the Advisory Board, be subject to ejection from that meeting.

  - A. **WEHO LIFE PROGRAM PRESENTATION AND UPDATES (20-30 min)**  
The Board will receive a presentation from the Los Angeles LGBT Center WeHo Life Program, which provides health education and harm reduction information and materials to West Hollywood community members and businesses. WeHo Life works in partnership with the City to distribute drink-spiking test strips that are designed to detect the possible presence of “date rape” drugs, such as GHB (gamma hydroxybutyrate) or ketamine.
