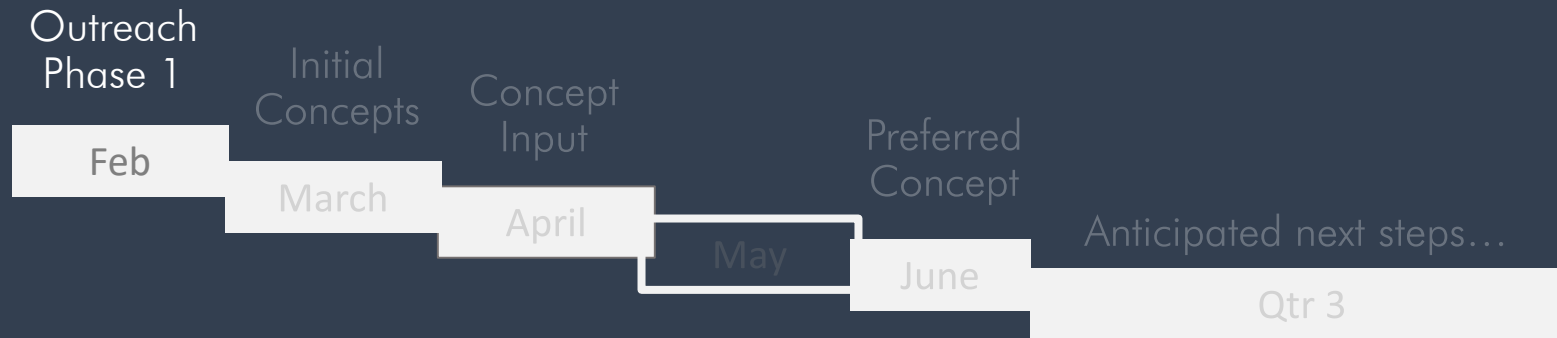

#### Provide or modify accessible spaces

Notes: Two accessible parking spaces are provided. A van accessible parking provided (1 van space min).

Notes: A "Van Accessible" sign is not provided. Required: A "Van Accessible" posted at stalls striped and designated to be van accessible.

### Outreach results • Park visitation + frequency

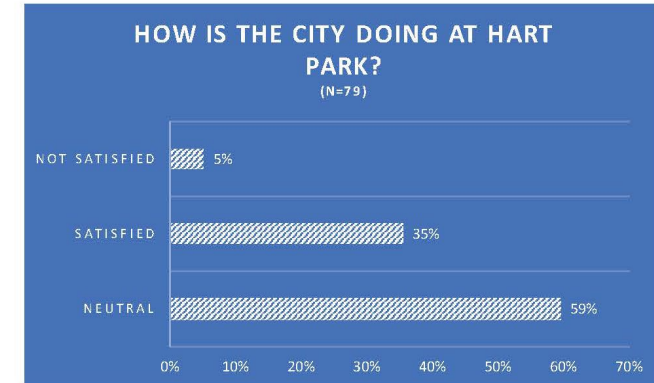
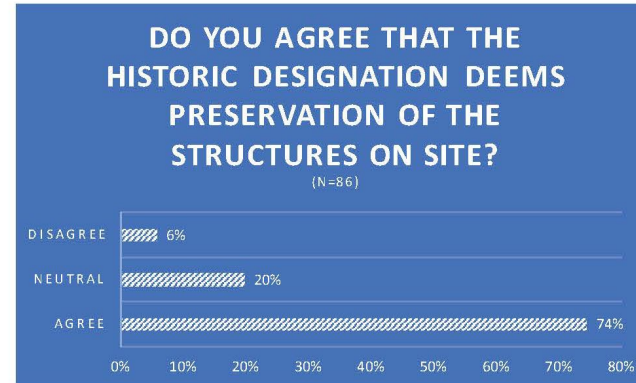

#### What elements would make Hart Park more enjoyable or usable?

- Fountain improved for birds and wildlife to utilize
- Need better maintenance and wood should be replaced more often
- Wood chips are good/maintenance not regular
- Keep chips! Astro smells
- On site security. I was assaulted by homeless on Nov 12th
- Fencing is too low! My dog jumps the fence!
- Adhere to natural environment as much as possible
- Additional police officer
- Improve access from Sunset (Blvd)
- More access along De Longpre [St.] Park should be more open to street + more inviting.
- Dog park is too big - shouldn't dominate center of park - maybe on the perimeter
- Lighting is important
- Make easy to find a non-emergency number to call
- No astroturf (hot on dog paws)
- Parking is easier (and free) in the afternoon
- Yes on grass turf (artificial)
- Keep dogs on a leash outside of dog park

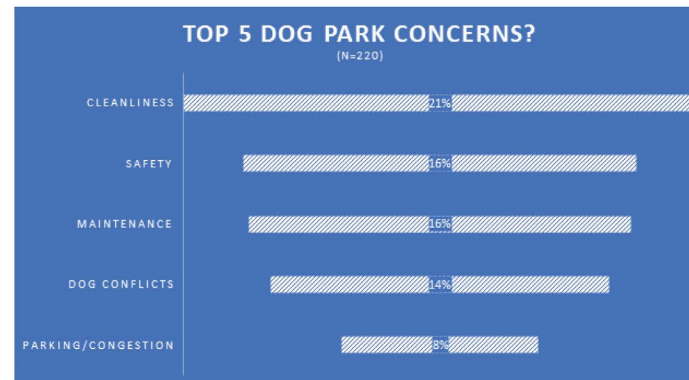
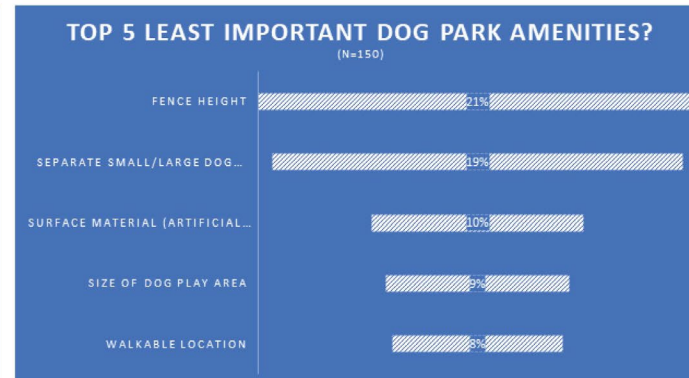
1. Surfacing (wood chips(15), artificial turf(10))

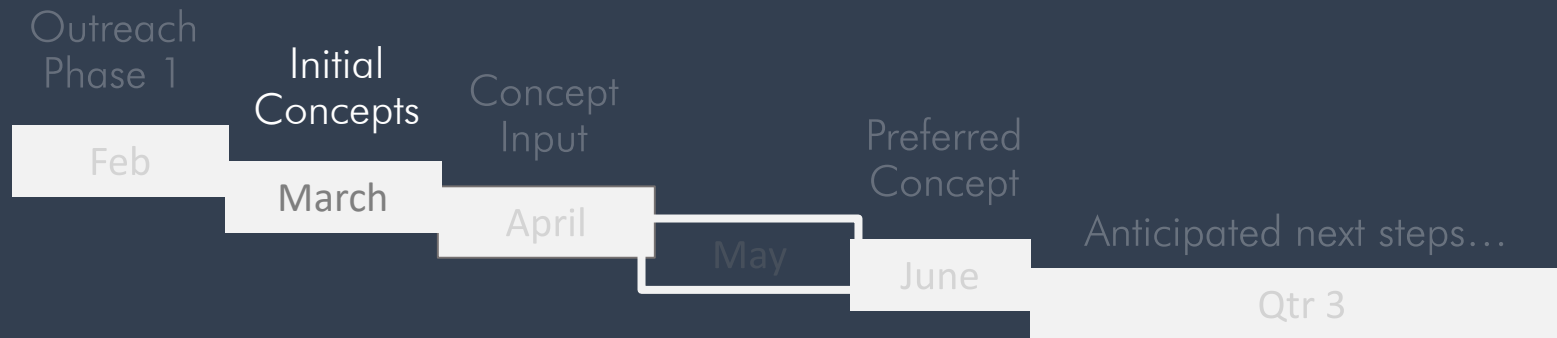
