Any member of the public may address the design review subcommittee on items not appearing on the agenda under Comments from the Public. Comments concerning other items on the agenda will be heard at the time the item is considered during the course of the meeting.

Speakers should not bring to the podium any items other than a prepared written statement and/or writing materials.

Speakers and any other members of the public may not approach Design Review subcommittee members at any time during the meeting without prior consent from the Chair. Speakers may only speak once on any agenda item. Donating public comment time to others is prohibited.

The City expects that everyone who participates in the meeting will do so with respect and dignity. Please refrain from using abusive, derogatory, and slanderous language, or behaving in a way that disrupts the meeting.

Members of the audience shall not engage in disorderly or boisterous conduct, including the utterance of loud, threatening, or abusive language, whistling, stamping of feet or other acts which disturb, disrupt, impede, or otherwise render the orderly conduct of the Design Review Subcommittee meeting unfeasible.
