**C**ouncilmember Chelsea Lee Byers was elected to the West Hollywood City Council on November 8, 2022.

Her priorities on the City Council include addressing livability and affordability challenges, social service delivery, climate-change mitigation strategies, creating more affordable housing and resources for renters, enhancing the streetscape for improved pedestrian and cycling experiences while reducing vehicle-dependency, and community-building and policy implementation to ensure the City of West Hollywood is an inclusive community for all.

Byers serves as Chair for the Westside Cities Council of Governments. She is appointed as the alternate for the County of Los Angeles Board of Supervisors, Lindsey P. Horvath, on the Los Angeles County Affordable Housing Solutions Agency (LACAHS). In addition, Byers serves as Vice Chair on the League of

California Cities Transportation, Communications, and Public Works Committee and as the Vice Chair on the National League of Cities Federal Transportation, Infrastructure, and Services (TIS) Federal Advocacy Committee. She is also the President of the LGBTQ+ Caucus for League of California Cities.

She currently serves as Chair for the West Hollywood City Council Homelessness Subcommittee, and serves on the Ad-hoc committees for Code of Conduct and the Rent Stabilization Ordinance.

Byers has participated in a number of fellowships including the Housing Policy Leadership Institute, New Leaders Council, Art for LA Activate Program, National Council for Jewish Women's Advocacy Program, and the James Lawson Institute. She currently serves on the Board of Directors for the National Women's Political Caucus as the Vice President of Education and Training for NWPC California.

Byers studied at Universidad Internacional Cuernavaca and Franklin University Switzerland and received her B.A. in Political Science and Women's Studies from Northern Arizona University.
