COMPREHENSIVE PROGRAMS

[SoCalREN's Multifamily Program](#)

Financial and technical support for efficiency measures for whole building or common areas. Program covers up to 60–75% of eligible project costs.

[Low-Income Weatherization Program](#)

Financial and technical support for affordable housing owners. Covers 30–100% of efficiency upgrades and 50–100% of solar installations.

[Green Homes California \(USGBC-CA\)](#)

Educational resources for building owners and residents to plan, fund, and execute projects that lower utility costs, improve health, and reduce GHG emissions.

EQUIPMENT REBATES & INSTALLATIONS

[Instant AC Savings \(Clean Power Alliance\)](#)

Instant rebate to purchase a high efficiency room air conditioner. \$300 rebate for income-qualified applicants.

[Charge4All \(USGBC-CA\)](#)

Financial and installation support of no-cost EV chargers for eligible buildings 50 dwelling units and higher. Funds 10 years of operations and maintenance.

[Solar On Multifamily Affordable Housing](#)

Financial and installation support of solar panels and related systems for eligible multifamily affordable housing buildings.

[Heat Pump Incentives \(TECH Clean CA\)](#)

Rebates for HVAC, heat pump water heater, and related appliances. *Paused due to federal funding as of Feb 2025, but new funding expected to resume soon.*
