- iii. Remove all future design services from the STV consultant team's scope of work for the following corridor segments on Santa Monica Blvd:
  1. 5<sup>th</sup> St to 14<sup>th</sup> St
  2. 14<sup>th</sup> St to Harvard St
  3. Harvard St to Centinela Av

iv. Authorize WSCCOG staff to work with the WSCCOG Design Working Group to submit a programming request to Metro for up to \$3,979,932 in SEP funds for the Westside Bus Connection Program and to distribute:

1. Up to **\$600,000** to the City of Santa Monica for design and implementation of bus, bicycle, and pedestrian infrastructure on Santa Monica Blvd between 5<sup>th</sup> St and 14<sup>th</sup> St and between Harvard St and Centinela Av contingent upon Santa Monica City Council approval of dedicated bus lanes on this segment.
2. Up to **\$200,000** to the City of Los Angeles for the review and implementation of WSCCOG-funded Westside Bus Connection designs.
3. The remaining **\$3,179,932** to consultants and member jurisdictions as needed to complete design and implementation.
