Special Presentations on the Implementation of Phase 1 of the West Hollywood Park Master Plan on Tuesday, April 7, 2009 and Saturday, April 11, 2009 at West Hollywood Park

Meet the Project Team including City Staff, Architects, Contractor and Project Manager

WEST HOLLYWOOD - The City of West Hollywood, West Hollywood Chamber of Commerce and Avenues of Arts and Design will host a special presentation for the business community on the construction of Phase 1 of the West Hollywood Park Master Plan on Tuesday, April 7, 2009 starting at 6:30 p.m. at West Hollywood Park Auditorium, 647 N. San Vicente Boulevard. (Phase 1 of the West Hollywood Park Master Plan is one of the major components of the City of West Hollywood's 25th Anniversary Project).

A special presentation for residents on the construction project will also be held on Saturday, April 11, 2009 at 10 a.m. at West Hollywood Park Auditorium, 647 N. San Vicente Boulevard. Both presentations will include an overview of Phase 1 of the West Hollywood Park Master Plan, artist renderings, a meet and greet with the Project Team including city staff, architects, contractor and project manager, followed by a question and answer session.

“The 25th Anniversary Capital Project will expand badly needed infrastructure, add public parking and lay the foundation for the next quarter-century of success in the City of West Hollywood,” said West Hollywood Mayor Jeffrey Prang. “These special presentations will help each and every resident and business owner to be an informed partner as we build our City's future together,” he continued.

Phase 1 of the West Hollywood Park Master Plan will include a new 44,000 square foot, state-of-the-art library, designed to achieve a Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) rating and be a certified “Green Building;” a 2.5 acre increase in parkland and green space; new tennis courts; and more than 400 parking spaces in two municipal garages. The project is scheduled to break ground in June 2009.
