#### II. LA County Flood Control Districts' Water Quality Funding Initiative

Russ Bryden, Civil Engineer, LA County Flood Control District, will provide an update on the District's ongoing efforts to develop a voter-approved initiative that will provide an ongoing source of funding to jurisdictions, on a parcel-based fee, to help local jurisdictions comply with water quality standards and storm water management requirements. The release of the draft ordinance has been delayed and consequently the comment period extended.

#### IV. Westside Cities COG Bicycle Plan Update

Staff of the Transportation and Sustainability Committees continues to work on the COG's Westside Bicycle Coordination Plan. The first draft sub-regional map of existing and proposed bicycle infrastructure has been developed. The committee presented three areas for Board review at its May 19, 2011 meeting: Conceptual Framework, Potential Deliverables and For Further Study. The Board directed the ad hoc committee to proceed as outlined. A critical deliverable is a policy statement of mutual support for member jurisdictions' bicycle planning efforts that would assist in receiving regional cooperation points in grant applications. Principles included in the statement could include: 1) Close gaps in the bike network, and 2) Improve or add consistency to bike facilities. Committee input is sought on the content of the policy statement.

#### V. Energy Upgrade California

The contract with O'Rorke finalized and preliminary meetings with cities' staff and stakeholders have begun. The Board approved a contract with EcoMotion for technical support services. The contract will be executed shortly.
