II. City of Santa Monica Senior Transportation Services Update

Robin Davidson, Human Services Administrator, Families, Seniors & Disabilities Initiatives, will provide an update on the City of Santa Monica's comprehensive program of paratransit services for seniors and people with disabilities. The Dial-A-Ride program, a shared van service, provides assisted "door through door" service in addition to curb-to-curb service. Emergency and after hours taxi service are also available for qualifying circumstances. Further, as of July 2011, the City will fund a local multiservice agency serving seniors to provide a van with "door through door services" to complement existing Dial-A-Ride services, particularly during peak times, and expanded destinations.

III. Home for Good

A representative from Home For Good, a partnership between United Way of Greater Los Angeles and the L.A. Area Chamber of Commerce, will discuss this plan to end chronic and veteran homelessness by 2016. The plan calls for the use of existing resources to achieve these goals, and the presenter will talk about the critical role of local jurisdictions in partnering with these efforts. Home For Good is led by the Business Leaders Task Force on Homelessness, a group of 22 business leaders who have committed to lead this effort, and has been endorsed by over 80 cross-sector leaders.

The matrix of senior services will be prioritized based on such factors as service gaps; opportunities for joint efforts; limited/no opportunities for joint efforts; greatest need, etc.


